Summary

As a leading global provider of biogas upgrading systems, we are helping to clean up two of the largest and most difficult-to-decarbonize sectors of the global energy system: the natural gas grid and the commercial transportation sector. Our systems produce clean, low-carbon and carbon-negative renewable natural gas (RNG) from organic waste sources including landfills, wastewater treatment plants, dairy farms, and food waste. Greenlane is the only biogas upgrading company offering the three main technologies: water wash, pressure swing adsorption and membrane separation and has over 30 years industry experience, patented proprietary technology, over 100 hydrogen sulfide treatment systems sold, and over 135 biogas upgrading systems sold into 19 countries, including many of the largest RNG production facilities in the world. Greenlane is a publicly-traded company on the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSX: GRN).

The Director, QHS will be responsible for working in collaboration with all company functions to continuously improve the way we work. The successful candidate will play an important leadership role in establishing an effective Quality Management System (QMS), while ensuring that the organization meets all health and safety legislation and objectives and that appropriate risk mitigation/control measures are in place.

Duties & Responsibilities

- In collaboration with all internal functions, establish and maintain an organizational quality management system (QMS) based on a process approach designed to enhance customer satisfaction by meeting or exceeding customer requirements.
- On a continuous basis gather requirements from external interested parties, particularly customer and statutory and regulatory requirements, to ensure that their requirements are being consistently met.
- Oversee regularly scheduled management reviews of the Greenlane QMS to ensure that it is adequate, effective and suitable to the strategic direction of the company.
- Facilitate the definition and documentation of the company business processes.
- Track and report information to the Greenlane leadership team on the performance of the QMS, including metrics and trends in customer satisfaction, progress on established quality objectives, results of internal and external audits, adequacy of required resources, nonconformities and corrective and preventive actions and actions to address risks and opportunities.
- Provide continuous monitoring to ensure that all aspects of the business have the resources needed for the establishment, implementation, maintenance and continuous improvement of the Greenlane QMS.
- Conduct of regularly scheduled internal audits of all functional areas and work collaboratively with internal functions on the development and implementation of corrective and preventive actions to address non-conformances.
- Oversee the organizational process to capture and apply lessons-learned.



- Serve as the organization lead in preparing the company for ISO 9001 and ISO45001 and EGBC Registration certification assessments conducted by an external registrar. Oversee the action to address any non-conformances that may be identified.
- Using the FRACAS process, oversee the management of product quality issues from issue identification and assignment, protecting our customers, root cause analysis, corrective action and implementation of preventive measures.
- Provide support to the Supplier Quality Manager with overseeing the performance of our suppliers.
- Overall responsibility for risk assessment, audit review, monitoring & managing health and safety within the organization.
- Review and continuously improve the company's H&S policies and procedures to ensure they are up to date and relevant.

- Bachelor of Engineering or Business Degree with 15+ years of quality systems management experience, or equivalent education and experience.
- Certification as a Manager of Quality/Organizational Excellence, Quality Lead Auditor and/or Engineer by a recognized institution such as ASQ.
